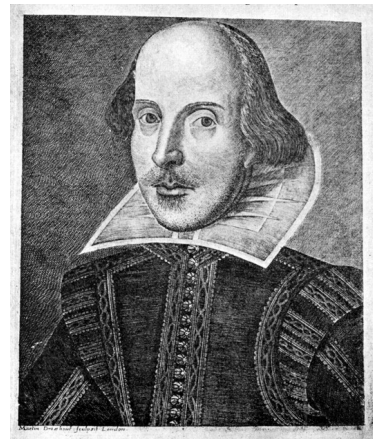


# Summer of Shakespeare

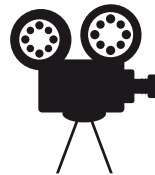
